Students are expected to develop proper attitudes, habits, work standards and professionalism to become exceptional educators of Theatre within Regional Theatre & other outreach type programs.

Admission: Students are admitted to the department and BFA degree program through separate application and interview with program faculty. Acceptance is competitive and not guaranteed.

Retention: Students must maintain B- or better grades in all courses required for major, and meet all department requirements. **Annual reviews are held for each student to determine** if students will: (A) Continue in the program. (B) Be placed on programmatic probation. (C) Be discontinued from the program. Students not retained in the program must select another major.

Departmental Requirements

- Enroll in production practicum every semester except the semesters enrolled in THEA 1513 or THEA 2203.
- Usher for one department production in the Morgan Theatre, and one production in either the Studio Theatre or Caine Lyric Theatre each semester, unless involved in the production. (Students take completion slips to be signed by the House Manager. Completion slips are submitted to the office following the close of the production.)
- Attend all production strikes.

Minimum GPA for Admission: 2.75

Minimum Grade Accepted: B- in all courses for major

Number of Required Credits: 69.5

Minimum GPA for Graduation: 2.75

Field work in Theatre comprises of an approved professional internship with a theatre or educational institution. Field research is also an option. 12 credits of internship requires the equivalent of 6 months full time employment. Credit is not expected to be completed all at once.

Capstone Project Requirements (2 credits)

All students must complete a capstone project during their Senior year. Students must be enrolled in THEA 5910, Capstone Project, during the semester in which the project is presented. All projects will be chosen in consultation with the student's advisor.
